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1 [REDACTED]: So we are now on the record.  
2 Today is September 6, 2024, and this is a  
3 transcribed interview of [REDACTED].

4 House Resolution 1367 directed this Task  
5 Force to investigate the facts and circumstances of  
6 the attempted assassination of Donald J. Trump on  
7 July 13, 2024 in Butler, Pennsylvania.

8 Pursuant to House Resolution 1367,  
9 Chairman Kelly and Ranking Member Crow have  
10 requested this interview as part of the Task Force  
11 investigation.

12 BY [REDACTED]:

13 Q. Can the witness please state their name and  
14 spell their last name for the record.

15 A. [REDACTED].

16 Q. Thank you, [REDACTED].

17 My name is [REDACTED], and I'm a senior  
18 counsel with the Task Force Majority Staff. I want  
19 to thank you for coming in today for this  
20 interview. The Task Force recognizes and  
21 appreciates that you are here voluntarily.

22 You're allowed to have an attorney  
23 present to advise you during this interview. Do  
24 you have an attorney representing you in a personal  
25 capacity present with you today?

1 [REDACTED]: Yes.

3 [REDACTED]: Is there also an attorney  
4 present representing Butler Township Police  
5 Department?

BY [REDACTED]:

Q. [REDACTED], before we begin, I'd like to go over the ground rules for this interview.

The way this interview will proceed is as follows:

The Majority and Minority staff will alternate asking you questions, 30 minutes per side per round, until each side is finished with their questioning.

The Majority staff will begin and proceed for 30 minutes, and then the Minority staff will have 30 minutes to ask questions. We will then alternate back and forth in this manner until both sides have no more questions.

If either side is in the middle of a specific line of questions, they may choose to end a few minutes past an hour to ensure completion of that specific line of questioning, including any pertinent followups.

In this interview, while one member of the staff for each side may lead the questioning, additional staff may ask questions.

There's a court reporter taking

everything down that I say and everything that you say to make a written record of the interview.

For the record to be clear, please wait until the staffer questioning you finishes each question before you begin your answer, and the staffer will wait until you finish your response before proceeding to the next question.

Further, to ensure the court reporter can properly record this interview, please speak clearly, concisely and slowly.

Also, the court reporter cannot record nonverbal answers, such as nodding or shaking your head. So it is important that you answer each question with an audible, verbal answer.

Do you understand?

A. Yes.

Q. We want you to answer our questions in the most complete and truthful manner possible, so we will take our time.

If you have any questions or do not fully understand the question, please let us know and we will attempt to clarify, add context to, or rephrase our questions.

Do you understand?

A. Yes.

1           Q.    If we ask about specific conversations or  
2           events in the past and you are unable to recall the  
3           exact words or details, you should testify to the  
4           substance of those conversations or events to the  
5           best of your recollection.

6                    If you recall only a part of a  
7           conversation or event, you should give us your best  
8           recollection of those events or parts of  
9           conversations that you do recall.

10                   Do you understand?

11           A.    Yes.

12           Q.    Although you are here voluntarily and we  
13           will not swear you in, you are required, pursuant  
14           to 18 U.S. Code § 1001, to answer questions from  
15           Congress truthfully. This also applies to  
16           questions posed by congressional staff in an  
17           interview.

18                   Do you understand?

19           A.    Yes.

20           Q.    If at any time you knowingly make false  
21           statements, you could be subject to criminal  
22           prosecution.

23                   Do you understand?

24           A.    Yes.

25           Q.    Is there any reason you are unable to

1 provide truthful testimony in today's interview?

2 A. Can you repeat that?

3 Q. Is there any reason you are unable to  
4 provide truthful testimony in today's interview?

5 A. No.

6 Q. Please note that if you wish to assert a  
7 privilege over any statement today, that assertion  
8 must apply with the rules of the U.S. House of  
9 Representatives.

10 For the Chair to consider assertions of  
11 privilege over testimony or statements, witnesses  
12 or entities must clearly state the specific  
13 privilege being asserted and the reason for the  
14 assertion on or before the scheduled date of  
15 testimony or appearance.

16 Do you understand?

17 A. Yes.

18 Q. Finally, I'd like to note that the content  
19 of what we discuss here today is confidential. We  
20 ask that you not speak about what we discuss here  
21 today in this interview to any outside individual  
22 in order to preserve the integrity of this  
23 investigation.

24 For those same reasons, the marked  
25 exhibits used today will be provided to the court



reporter so that they may go in the official transcript, and any copies of those exhibits will be returned to us when we wrap up.

We plan to take a five-minute break at the end of each 30 minutes of questioning, but if you need a longer break or a break before that, please let us know and we're happy to accommodate.

However, to the extent that there's a pending question, we would ask that you finish answering the question before we take the break.

Do you understand?

A. Yes.

Q. Do you have any other questions for us before we begin?

A. No.

Q. It is now 4:26, and the Majority staff will begin questions.

[REDACTED], thank you for being here today. As an initial matter, can you please describe to us your job description?

A. My job description would be patrolman for Butler Township Police. I don't know if you want me to go further into that.

Q. If you could please just --

A. Answer calls.

1 Q. -- outline your responsibilities and tasks  
2 and assignments.

3 A. Answer calls, provide traffic control,  
4 whatever. The day in question I would be just  
5 answering calls that day.

6 Q. And by answering calls, does that mean, you  
7 know, taking the patrol car out to respond?

8 What does that mean?

9 A. Yeah. I also had a patrol car assigned to  
10 me, as usually my zone of coverage would have been  
11 134 zone. So that was 422, like Walmart area.

12 I know you're not familiar with the  
13 zones in Butler, but Meridian, which is where the  
14 farm show is. Like Bon Aire would also be in my  
15 zone. That was my zone coverage that day.

16 That's every daylight Saturday how the  
17 rotation works. I usually end up with that zone.

18 Q. Okay. And just as a general matter, can  
19 you just explain your responsibilities on a  
20 day-to-day basis a little more for us in terms of  
21 what you're responsible for and what you do?

22 A. Answer calls. Investigate crashes.  
23 Investigate crimes. Conduct traffic stops. Normal  
24 patrol work.

25 Q. Thank you. And how long have you worked

1 for the Butler Township Police Department?

2 A. It will be 15 years in October.

3 Q. For the July 13th event, the campaign rally  
4 at the Butler farm show, can you describe when you  
5 became first aware of that event taking place on  
6 July 13th?

7 A. The week prior. I don't have the day for  
8 you.

9 Q. How did you become aware of it?

10 Did someone tell you that it was  
11 happening? Did you receive an e-mail?

12 A. Through social media, and we talked about  
13 it at the station. Kind of simultaneously.

14 Q. When did you learn that you would be  
15 working at the July 13th event?

16 A. I was working that day.

17 Q. And how did you learn it? Like through  
18 your boss?

19 Did anyone tell you that you would be  
20 working?

21 A. I was scheduled to work that day.

22 [REDACTED]: Point of  
23 clarification: [REDACTED] is asking were you assigned  
24 to this event, and your answer is for that day.

25 [REDACTED] My day was patrol that

day.

: Do you understand what he's --

: Yes.

A. Just to clarify, I was scheduled to work that day for patrol, and my zone of patrol was the farm show.

Q. Thank you for talking through that with us. Did you receive any documents or any specific instructions for that day that were specific to the campaign rally?

Any type of operational plan or aerial diagrams or maps?

A. So there was an operational plan, and I was not -- I believe I'm in it. You asked the guy working the road, and I was in it there.

I sat through the briefing just so I would know what was going on, but I was not part of the event.

But there's 25,000 people, or however many it was there, in a small area, and most likely, all my calls would be from the event.

So I sat through the event -- or I sat through the briefing.

Q. And when did that briefing take place?

1           A.     It was either 09 or 10. I'm not exactly  
2     sure.

3           Q.     And that was at the station?

4           A.     Yeah, it was at the station.

5           Q.     I'm going to introduce a document for the  
6     record here. This will be Majority Exhibit 1.

7                     (Majority Exhibit No. 1 was marked for  
8     identification.)

9     BY MR. KELLY:

10          Q.     When you say your briefing took -- is that  
11     the morning of July 13th?

12          A.     Yes.

13          Q.     That's the only time you sat in on any type  
14     of briefing or anything?

15          A.     For this event, yes.

16          Q.     For that event, yes. Specifically that  
17     event on that day.

18          A.     But I also was aware that I was working the  
19     road. So I knew I was not going to be part of this  
20     plan.

21          Q.     Okay. All right. That's fine.

22     BY [REDACTED]

23          Q.     Do you recognize this document?

24          A.     I believe so.

25          Q.     So this document is labeled the Butler

Township Operational Plan. The mission of this operational plan is to provide traffic control at various intersections in and around Butler Farm Show grounds.

On the Assignments page on Page 2, there's a number of intersections listed, and some of the intersections have Butler Township personnel tasked at those specific intersections.

Do you recognize your name on this Assignments sheet?

A. No.

Q. There's a patrol unit identified at the Greenwood Drive intersection at SR 0422.

A. But that's not specific to me either.

Q. That's not specific to you?

A. There's two patrol officers on that day.

Q. Okay. And you were in the other patrol unit?

A. I was in one patrol unit. The other patrol unit was going to be the zone like south of us. So that would have been like Lyndora, South Butler, that kind of stuff.

So had I been tied up, [REDACTED] could have come up and handled that. I'm assuming that's where he meant when he says patrol unit.

1 Q. I'm on the last pages of this packet.  
2 There's an Intersections of Responsibility that  
3 list some intersections. I think it's a few pages  
4 prior to there.

5 On this map, can you describe where your  
6 patrol zone was located? If you want to use my  
7 copy, here.

8 A. It would start up here at 422. We cover  
9 422 and the whole way down to below Buttercup. So  
10 pretty much here (indicating).

11 I'm not exactly sure on the map where,  
12 if I can draw a line. Do you know what I mean?

13 Q. Uh-huh.

14 A. The line from Butler Township would be over  
15 here (indicating) somewhere, and everything east of  
16 that.

17 Q. Okay.

18 A. Does that make sense?

19 Q. So your patrol was more of a roving duty on  
20 July 13th?

21 A. Yes.

22 Q. So you could be at various places all  
23 around the Butler Farm Show grounds?

24 A. Yes. And all Butler Farm Show is not  
25 actually in Butler Township.

1 Q. That's right.

2 A. So it was, like I said, everything east of  
3 that, and a lot of the farm show is not. But just  
4 because I needed to get around, I was over that  
5 way. I usually don't end up over that way.

6 Q. Okay. At the July 13th event, can you  
7 describe getting to the AGR building and how you  
8 came to arrive at the AGR building that day?

9 A. Specific to when?

10 Q. At any point you were in or about the area  
11 of the AGR building.

12 A. You mean for the active shooter or just --

13 Q. Just in your patrol, were you around the  
14 AGR building? Were you driving past it? Were you  
15 walking by it?

16 A. I was driving up and down Whitestown Road.  
17 I don't know how many times I would have drove by  
18 it. I drove by Meridian.

19 Like I said, I was getting calls and I  
20 was patrolling that area. So I would have been  
21 driving by it countless times.

22 Q. Countless times?

23 A. I have no idea.

24 Q. So countless times driving by the AGR  
25 building around that area?



1 A. Probably more on Meridian Road, but, yeah.

2 Q. On Meridian Road.

3 During that time, are you driving by the  
4 AGR building, or just in and around the Butler Farm  
5 Show grounds, did you hear any reports of a  
6 suspicious individual?

7 A. So are you talking about the specific event  
8 of the shooter? How I got my information was I  
9 went and checked on -- as you know, we had  
10 different guys at the intersection, and I just  
11 checked in on them to see how they're doing. Talk  
12 for a minute.

13 I checked on [REDACTED], Patrolman [REDACTED].  
14 I was talking to him when he received information  
15 of the guy with the range finder, and then Secret  
16 Service was standing there with us, and [REDACTED]  
17 ended up messaging me a picture of them.

18 Q. Okay. So you were physically with [REDACTED]  
19 checking in on him?

20 A. Yes. I was just literally checking on him.  
21 "Hey, do you got water, whatever," yeah.

22 Q. Driving past [REDACTED] station?

23 A. Yes.

24 Q. Where his post was stationed?

25 A. He was there with a Secret Service member.

1 Q. With who? I'm sorry.

2 A. It was him and a Secret Service member at  
3 Brady Paul Lane.

4 Q. Brady Paul Lane, okay.

5 Do you recall around what time that was?

6 A. It might be on -- we did a timeline. It  
7 might be on the timeline turned in.

8 Q. And what was your conversation with [REDACTED]  
9 during that time?

10 What did he say about the suspicious  
11 person?

12 A. He had a range finder.

13 Q. He had a range finder.

14 A. The sniper spotted him with a range finder.

15 Q. Do you do anything with that information  
16 via your radio?

17 A. I was on County 2. I was not on OPS 3. I  
18 was not on OPS 4. I was scanning them, but when  
19 you're scanning those other frequencies and you're  
20 on County 2, anything that comes up on County 2, it  
21 overrides county traffic. Like County 2, actually,  
22 overrides those.

23 We talked about it. After a short  
24 conversation, I went back down Meridian Road.  
25 There's a water tower somewhere over there. We

1       drove back to the water tower just to see if I  
2       could see him.

3               There was a trooper sitting there. I  
4       couldn't see the trooper sitting there from where  
5       we were on Brady Paul Lane.

6       Q.     And that trooper was state police?

7       A.     Yes. It was a state trooper in a marked  
8       unit. We just couldn't see him. I didn't know he  
9       was there.

10              I said something to the trooper about,  
11       "Hey, there's a guy." I gave a description. I  
12       can't give the description off the top of my head  
13       right now.

14              "There was a description of this man.  
15       Have you seen him?" He's like no, he didn't see  
16       him either.

17              I looked around. I could see -- from  
18       the tower to AGR, I could see there was like nobody  
19       fitting that description. I think there was maybe  
20       like one person walking through.

21       Q.     Okay. And when you had that conversation  
22       with the state trooper, that was in person.

23              You stopped by where he was located?

24       A.     Yes. Yes.

25       Q.     And was there any other personnel from

1 Butler Township at that time there?

2 A. No.

3 Q. So do you keep driving south on Meridian  
4 after talking with the state police trooper?

5 A. I go back out to Meridian Road, and I again  
6 stop and talk to [REDACTED] and Secret Service because  
7 they're still talking about this.

8 And then [REDACTED] -- and I'm not sure  
9 who it comes from, if it was the Secret Service to  
10 [REDACTED] or just the Secret Service member himself.  
11 I remember there was some talk about it. I think  
12 all three of us. I think the Secret Service called  
13 it in. I have no idea. But the Secret Service  
14 said, "If you find him, we'll talk to him."

15 So I then drove south on Meridian Road  
16 to see if I could find him.

17 Q. Okay. At what point did you know that the  
18 threat had been elevated of the suspicious person  
19 and you might be needed to go back to the building  
20 or take another action?

21 A. So I went south. I think at Buttercup I  
22 made a right, came back out Grist, and then went  
23 back on 68, which would have been right by AGR.  
24 There was a report of the same individual between  
25 AGR and going towards Sheetz.

1 Q. Okay.

2 A. And then I started from there.

3 Q. Okay. What radio channel did you get that  
4 information?

5 Was that police channel 2?

6 A. I don't think it was on 2. I'm not  
7 watching the radio. I don't have to watch the  
8 radio. Do you know what I mean?

9 Like while I'm driving down the road, I  
10 don't have to look at the radio to see what  
11 channel's popping up.

12 I think it was OPS 3, but I don't know  
13 for sure, to be honest.

14 Q. So you hear that the suspicious individual  
15 is going towards Sheetz. So you cut in and you  
16 follow that direction?

17 A. Yes.

18 Q. Can you describe the next steps that you  
19 took?

20 A. Well, I believe before I got there -- well,  
21 we pull in, come around. So one of the snipers  
22 comes out. I believe it was from Beaver County  
23 because I did not recognize him. I don't know who  
24 he was. I know he was one of the snipers from the  
25 ESU team, but I did not recognize him.

He said, "Well, the guy went that" -- kind of pointed, and he pointed back towards the building, and if you've been around the building, you know how confusing the building is with how the cuts and -- it's really extremely confusing, and I did not know that you couldn't go from, like, one side to the other side the way those warehouses are kind of stacked in there.

So he said he went that way. So I looked, and as I drove by, I was like, "Where did he go?" Because I wasn't sure, to be honest.

So I started back around the building. The other side, when I was on the other side of the building, Patrolman [REDACTED], I can hear him saying somebody was on the roof.

After he said somebody was on the roof, I turned around and started back towards where his location was, assuming that I could see him from there, where Patrolman [REDACTED] was, because he was coming up that way.

And then I believe when he radioed that, somebody else radioed that we didn't have any assets on the roof. Again, I don't know who that was that said that, but that makes sense. It didn't make sense. Put it that way.

1           Q.    Do you know at that time what radio  
2 transmission that came in on?

3                   Was that police officer Channel 2?  Was  
4 that OPS 3?

5           A.    Probably OPS 3.  Again, I'm on 2 but  
6 scanning 3.

7           Q.    Yeah.

8           A.    My main purpose is to answer calls on 2.

9           Q.    Yes.

10          A.    Obviously, this comes in and overrides  
11 that, but my main purpose there is to answer calls  
12 on 2.

13          Q.    Just to back up a step, around the time  
14 that you hear that there's a suspicious individual  
15 that's cutting towards Sheetz and you cut in, you  
16 meet a ESU sniper.

17                   You don't know what sniper they're  
18 affiliated with, what group they're affiliated  
19 with, but is that interaction like in person?

20                   Are you in your patrol car at that  
21 point?

22          A.    I'm in my patrol car.  He comes out and  
23 yells to us and said, "He went this way."

24                   So it was in person.  I'm in a patrol  
25 car.  I didn't get out.

1 Q. Okay. And then you encounter Officer [REDACTED].  
2 Are you also in the patrol car then?

3 A. I don't encounter [REDACTED]. I hear him on the  
4 radio.

5 Q. Hear him on the radio, okay.

6 So after speaking with the ESU sniper  
7 from your car, you keep driving.

8 Where do you go?

9 A. Around the other side of the building.

10 Q. Okay. And that's towards the AGR parking  
11 lot; correct?

12 A. Towards -- no. He was in the parking lot.  
13 There's different parking lots for the AGR  
14 building, but the main parking lot -- I'm assuming  
15 what you're referring to -- is where I would have  
16 seen the sniper and he pointed back towards, like,  
17 the building as he, like, went between the building  
18 or something. That's when I went back around the  
19 front of the building.

20 Q. Had you seen the suspicious individual at  
21 any point with your own eyes?

22 A. Mr. Crooks?

23 Q. Yes.

24 A. Earlier that day I did see him, and the  
25 only reason I know that is because he has such a



1 recognizable face. But I do not remember where I  
2 seen him at.

3 Q. Do you remember around what time you might  
4 have seen him?

5 A. I remember seeing a picture of him, like I  
6 seen here today, just because his face is that  
7 recognizable.

8 Q. And you said you saw a picture of him?

9 A. Yes.

10 Q. And that was on your phone?

11 A. Yes.

12 Q. Do you remember who sent that picture?

13 A. [REDACTED] sent that to me.

14 [REDACTED]: I'm sorry. Who sent it?

15 [REDACTED]: [REDACTED].

16 Q. So you've heard -- you had spoken with the  
17 ESU sniper. You've heard Officer [REDACTED] over the  
18 radio.

19 Can you describe your next actions?

20 A. He described the guy on the roof. I came  
21 back around to the parking lot where I originally  
22 seen the sniper, and everybody came pulling in,  
23 starting to kind of surround the building.

24 Patrolman [REDACTED] said, you know, "We're  
25 gonna have to get on the roof." So however --

where [REDACTED] was, I have no idea. Me and him get together. I don't even know how they got there.

But me and him get together, and I say something to [REDACTED] like, "Hey, I'll push you up; you pull me up." And I push him onto -- like lift him onto the roof.

He puts his foot between my two hands and I lift him up the best I can because there are no ladders. We didn't see any other way up. And that was the shortest point that we could find.

I'm not saying that there weren't other ones, but that's the best we could do at the time.

Q. So you're actively looking for places where you could possibly get on the roof?

A. Yes. That's the best we could come up with in a hastily fashion of trying to get up there.

I try to get him up to the roof. He's kind of on the side, however he is up there.

He comes back down screaming, "THERE'S AN AR! AN AR! A GUY WITH AN AR!"

He comes down, kind of, onto me and rolls his ankle, and we back up, drop down, obviously.

And then within a few seconds after that, we actually -- well, back up. I know the

trooper called it out. I believe [REDACTED] called it out, too: THERE'S AN AR, A GUY WITH AN AR OR A LONG GUN ON THE ROOF!"

The trooper is in his car, and I could see him. He said, "Did you guys call it out?" And he called it out again on his frequency. I have no idea what frequency he was on. So I have no idea.

But I know he called it out, and then that's when we got back up. We draw weapons, and a few seconds after that we hear shooting, both going out and then coming in.

Q. Okay. After you heard shots, what was your reaction?

A. The shots?

Q. Yeah.

A. Well, you could hear shots going out, and you heard one come in. Well, I didn't hear the two come in. I only heard the one come in that was loud, and we all kind of -- I knew that was a hit from the way everybody else was saying that you could hear it hit the building or hit him or the building.

Then after he was shot and they said, "Shooter down," I believe we started clearing AGR itself.

1 Q. Okay. And for what purpose was that?

2 A. To ensure that nobody else was inside the  
3 building.

4 Q. Okay. And where did you receive that  
5 instruction to clear the building?

6 A. I do not know.

7 Q. Were you able to successfully clear the AGR  
8 building for any other suspicious individuals or  
9 make sure that the building was clear?

10 A. We did. It took quite some time.

11 Q. About how long would you say that it took?

12 A. It's hard to guess on time, especially in  
13 that situation, but we went through, I would say,  
14 anywhere between a half hour and an hour.

15 Q. Were you clearing the building with other  
16 local law enforcement entities?

17 A. Some people, I had no idea who they were.

18 Q. Okay.

19 A. The first stack that went in there, it was  
20 guys I had no idea who they were.

21 Q. Did you recognize any Secret Service  
22 officials there helping clear the building?

23 A. One of them came in, wouldn't really talk  
24 to anybody, and then would come back, walk out. I  
25 have no idea who he was.

1 Q. Was he there until the completion of  
2 searching the AGR building after the shots?

3 A. I didn't see that guy again. He had a blue  
4 vest on that said Secret Service. Because I asked  
5 him if everybody was okay. He just went, "Eh, I  
6 don't know."

7 Q. What did you think about that?

8 A. What did I think about that? I'd just  
9 rather hold my opinion to myself.

10 Q. What did you do after you cleared the AGR  
11 building?

12 Did you stay around the AGR building.  
13 Did you resume your patrol?

14 A. After I cleared the AGR building, I went  
15 back out to the fence line. There was some more  
16 communication.

17 Like I carried a box of gloves over and  
18 threw them onto the roof for the guys, and then  
19 after that, I went out and stood on the perimeter  
20 for however many hours it was.

21 Q. When did you ultimately end up leaving the  
22 Butler Farm Show grounds and leave your work for  
23 that day?

24 A. At some point we went to the CP to give  
25 a -- it was what? 11:30 at night, somewhere in

there. I don't have my timeline in front of me.

I gave a quick statement to PSP Butler -- or not Butler -- just the Pennsylvania State Police -- which was recorded that night, and I was relieved from there.

I had to go back and get my car to go back to the AGR and still parked where I originally was parked, got my car and then left.

Q. When you went to the CP, do you mean the command post?

A. Yes.

Q. And where was that command post?

Was it the local trailer that had local law enforcement entities or was ---

A. I was not in it. So I can't tell you who was in command of that post. I just know we were to go up to the CP. There were a lot of guys walking around. I didn't know who they all were.

There were some individuals when we first came in on the left that had Secret Service on them. They were sitting in chairs.

There were a lot of people in the building. I recognized some of them as PSP. I didn't recognize a lot of other people. So I can't tell you who was who, other than I can tell you

1 Secret Service were wearing vests that said Secret  
2 Service, and I could see there were some troopers I  
3 recognized.

4 Other than that, I have no idea who a  
5 lot of those people were.

6 Q. Yeah. So this a really a building that you  
7 were reporting to at the end of the day.

8 And was that maybe towards, you know,  
9 the front of the Butler Farm Show grounds?

10 A. It was towards the front, and I never went  
11 inside. I gave my statement outside.

12 Q. Okay. And you gave that statement to  
13 Pennsylvania State Police?

14 A. Yes. And I cannot remember their names.

15 Q. After giving that statement, before coming  
16 to talk to us, had you prepared any type of After-  
17 Action Report or other similar type oral or written  
18 statement about the events of July 13th?

19 A. I gave a statement to Pennsylvania State  
20 Police and the FBI that week following. I don't  
21 know what day it was.

22 Q. And was that a separate interaction with  
23 both entities, or were they together?

24 A. They were together.

25 Q. They were together?

1           A.     It was -- I forget his name. He was kind  
2 of running the interview. State police would have  
3 been kind of running the interview, and then FBI  
4 was standing -- sitting on both sides. They really  
5 didn't have much other than a few things here and  
6 there.

7           Q.     During your patrol during the day of  
8 July 13th, did you identify any other suspicious  
9 individuals, other than Crooks, during your work?

10          A.     No.

11 [REDACTED]  
12          Q.     You mentioned Officer [REDACTED] had texted you  
13 a picture of what you eventually appreciated to be  
14 Mr. Crooks.

15          A.     Yeah.

16          Q.     Had you received any other texts that day?

17          A.     What do you mean? From...?

18          Q.     Independent of Crooks but just as far as  
19 communicating with fellow law enforcement.

20          A.     I don't know. Sometimes myself and  
21 Sergeant [REDACTED] will call each other or text each  
22 other if the radio traffic's tied up. It's not  
23 uncommon for us to do that.

24                   Just be like, "Hey, I got" -- do you  
25 know what I mean? Just a quick. And I can't



1 remember.

2 Q. Sure.

3 A. And I was there since 8:00, so I'm guessing  
4 I contacted a fellow officer. I presume that I  
5 would have contacted a fellow officer. Do you know  
6 what I mean?

7 I was there since at 8 a.m., and that  
8 was what time it occurred. So I'm sure there was  
9 some other contact with other officers.

10 Q. What about e-mail? Was that also a way to  
11 get in touch with people?

12 Was e-mail also a way to get in touch  
13 with folks the same way as text was?

14 A. No.

15 Q. No?

16 [REDACTED] We're at time for our staff.

17 [REDACTED]: The chairman has a  
18 question.

19 BY MR. KELLY:

20 Q. So you were hoisting Officer [REDACTED] up  
21 onto the roof; is that correct?

22 So he would have been right below the  
23 roof that the shooter was on?

24 A. Yes.

25 Q. Okay. So when you said earlier you hear

1 the shots, there were two other shots after that  
2 were incoming towards the shooter?

3 You detected two shots coming in?

4 A. I heard the one for sure because it was  
5 louder and it sounded different.

6 So I could hear his shots going out. I  
7 know two shots came in. I could identify the one  
8 that came in because it was coming in much louder.

9 [REDACTED]: Which one is that?

10 [REDACTED]: That would have been the  
11 last shot.

12 Q. The last shot?

13 A. Yeah.

14 Q. So I didn't realize there were two shots  
15 that came in. What I thought --

16 A. I thought there were two shots because of  
17 the other sniper shot, too, and then Secret  
18 Service, but I heard for sure one shot come in.

19 Q. Okay. So when you said that you thought  
20 the Secret Service sniper and then the other  
21 sniper, who would that have been?

22 One of ours?

23 A. One of ours, yes.

24 Q. But there's definitely two shots that came  
25 in?

1           A.    From my understanding, yes, two shots came  
2 in, but I heard one shot.

3           Q.    So you heard one shot, but you assumed  
4 there were two shots.

5                   Why do you assume?

6           A.    I know there's two shots now.

7           Q.    You know it now?

8           A.    I know that now.

9           Q.    Based on what?

10          A.    Based on talking to my colleagues.

11          Q.    So somebody else had told you there were  
12 actually two shots?

13          A.    Yes.

14          Q.    You knew for sure you heard one?

15          A.    Yes.

16          Q.    But you are assuming the second shot that  
17 came in you didn't hear or you weren't able to  
18 distinguish it?

19          A.    I wasn't able to distinguish it.

20          Q.    Okay.

21          A.    I wasn't able to distinguish the one shot  
22 that came in. The one shot that I was able to  
23 distinguish was a larger caliber and for sure was  
24 coming in.

25          Q.    I'm just trying to figure it out because,

1 being there, I heard the shots that were taken. I  
2 didn't realize there were more shots after that.

3 So it's hard for me to distinguish  
4 because when it was all happening, I wasn't  
5 counting shots. I was trying to cover [REDACTED].  
6 So it's interesting.

7 How many shots do you think Crooks took?

8 A. I didn't count that day, but afterwards I  
9 heard eight.

10 Q. Eight?

11 A. But I can't testify to that.

12 Q. I've heard the same thing. But again, any  
13 situation like that, who's counting? All I'm  
14 hearing is a series of gunshots.

15 A. Yes.

16 Q. And so I'm trying to understand.

17 My assumption was that -- my  
18 understanding is that there was communication,  
19 before the sniper on the roof, that he had him in  
20 his sight.

21 So he was waiting for the okay to act,  
22 and if the idea to engage was after Crooks had  
23 fired eight shots, I'm trying to understand --

24 A. I don't -- I can't make any sense for you  
25 on that one. All I know, from being involved here,

1 I know what a .223 sounds like.

2 Q. Yeah. But you know for sure you heard one  
3 incoming?

4 A. Yes. Without a doubt. It was one  
5 incoming. The one incoming was a much larger  
6 caliber.

7 Q. Would that have been one of our guys or the  
8 Secret Service?

9 A. I believe that was Secret Service.

10 Q. Okay.

11 A. Our guys were shooting the same caliber.

12 Q. Okay. All right. I'm just trying to  
13 figure out where the second shot came from.

14 You could definitely hear the first shot  
15 incoming, but...

16 A. And I can't tell you when those shots were,  
17 like.

18 Q. No, and that's okay.

19 A. But for sure the shot came in much louder  
20 and then everyone said "Shooter down" after that.

21 Q. Very good. Thanks, Officer.

22 [REDACTED]: Thank you. We'll go off the  
23 record.

24 (Off the record.)

25 BY [REDACTED]:

1           Q.    We can go back on the record.  It is 5:04  
2           p.m.  This is [REDACTED], Investigative Counsel  
3           for the Minority.

4                     Thank you again, sir, both for your  
5           service and for indulging us that it is 5 p.m. on a  
6           Friday afternoon on your day off.  So we will try  
7           to get through this as expeditiously as possible.

8                     I just want to cover, not to retread too  
9           much on what my colleagues covered, but just to  
10          make sure I sort of understand the flow of the day.

11                    As I understand it, Saturday afternoon  
12          or Saturday morning you were scheduled to be on  
13          patrol.  There was nothing -- you were not assigned  
14          to this, nor did you sort of sign up for overtime  
15          to be on a detail to cover the rally?

16          A.    Right.

17          Q.    Okay, great.

18                    So you were on patrol that day, and how  
19          you become aware that there even was a briefing?

20                    I think you mentioned that morning to  
21          discuss the rally and this operation plan that my  
22          colleagues discussed.

23          A.    There's not many of us that work there.

24          Q.    You showed up at work?

25          A.    Somebody said, "We're briefing."

1 Q. And saw that they were gathering?

2 A. Yeah.

3 Q. And what was covered in that briefing, that  
4 you recall?

5 A. The Township Operation Plan.

6 Q. Any understanding, during that briefing, of  
7 other law enforcement agencies that would be  
8 covering the rally and who might be sort of the  
9 head or lead agency in charge and how Butler  
10 Township police fit into that picture?

11 A. To be honest, I don't recall everything  
12 that was said.

13 Q. So walking away from that, what was your  
14 understanding of your role for the day?

15 A. Cover calls.

16 Q. Cover calls, driving. Okay.

17 And I think we said that the farm  
18 grounds is not entirely in Butler Township. So not  
19 entirely in your zone.

20 What about the AGR building  
21 specifically? Is that in Butler Township?

22 A. I believe that's Butler Township. I don't  
23 know if all the AGR property is.

24 Q. Fair enough. Because it's sort of a  
25 sprawling set of billings, as we were discussing?

1           A.     Yeah.   And I'm not sure where that line  
2 goes.

3           Q.     Were you familiar with it prior to  
4 July 13th from it being in your --

5           A.     Of that line?

6           Q.     Or just of that building?   Had you ever  
7 patrolled around there before?

8           A.     I've had, I think, a lot of calls there,  
9 but it had been a long time.

10          Q.     Okay.   Knowing that that building was sort  
11 of close to the rally site, did you have any  
12 reaction about this is something we should cover?  
13 Maybe I should or somebody should be in that area  
14 to cover it?

15          A.     We there told there were assets in the  
16 building.   So I kind of couldn't think about much  
17 other than that.

18          Q.     And who told you that?

19          A.     I don't recall.

20          Q.     And when you say "assets in the building,"  
21 what is that?

22          A.     There were snipers in the building.

23          Q.     Snipers from...?   Do you know what  
24 organization?

25          A.     No.    There were snipers who were going to



1 be in the building. I don't know when I found out  
2 it was Butler ESU snipers.

3 I don't even know if I found that out  
4 during the event or after the event. I just knew  
5 there were going to be assets in the building.

6 Q. But before the event, you knew there were  
7 going to be assets in the building?

8 A. Right.

9 Q. You were not sure who. Did you ever hear  
10 that there might be assets on the roof of the  
11 building?

12 A. I did not hear that.

13 Q. In hindsight, 20/20 always, would you have  
14 had assets on the roof? Does that --

15 [REDACTED] Is that a question you  
16 can even answer?

17 Q. Is that a question you can answer?

18 A. No, that's not a question that I can -- I'm  
19 not involved in the planning.

20 Q. Fair enough. Not involved in the planning.  
21 I'm asking more is your familiarity limited as of  
22 maybe with the building? Was that something that  
23 jumped out to you at any point? And it sounds like  
24 not; that you thought --

25 A. That is not my --

1 Q. Understood.

2 Between that briefing -- I think you  
3 said it was around 9 or 10 in the morning. The  
4 incident happens just after 6 p.m.

5 Generally, you're driving up and down, I  
6 believe you said, sort of Whitestown -- I think  
7 it's Whitestown Road and --

8 A. Meridian Road.

9 Q. -- Meridian Road.

10 A. Answering calls. At one point they called  
11 me, and I took somebody from the county, from the  
12 Trump, from the site, over to Sheetz to get a bunch  
13 of ice, and then I took them back.

14 Q. And I think you have a map in front of you  
15 that we have not yet marked, but I'll introduce it  
16 as Exhibit A.

17 (Minority Exhibit A was marked for  
18 identification.)

19 Q. This is a map that we have printed and  
20 might just help to quickly orient us. So I think  
21 that Whitestown Road is sort of towards the top  
22 where there's a yellow line there.

23 So you're sort of patrolling there. You  
24 come down what I'll call the side of the map. I'm  
25 not sure exactly how it's oriented -- north, south

1 east -- but it would be, I guess --

2 A. You realize I patrol a whole lot bigger  
3 area than this; right?

4 Q. Yes, I do.

5 A. Like miles outside of this, too.

6 Q. So on that day, how much of your time is  
7 spent sort of in this area versus the miles  
8 outside?

9 Mostly outside, I take it?

10 A. Like I said, there were going to be like  
11 25,000 residents there. I suspected all my  
12 problems for the day would be right here.

13 Q. Okay.

14 A. So I spent as much as I could here.

15 Q. So you did stick close to there, even  
16 though appreciating on any other Saturday, you  
17 would be much further out?

18 A. Yes. But, like I said, because of the  
19 amount of people, I knew where my problems would be  
20 that day.

21 Q. Understood.

22 So before any problems arise, I believe  
23 you said -- and I just want to confirm sort of  
24 where we are on the map -- that at some point you  
25 saw somebody from Pennsylvania State Police, a

1 state trooper, and a Secret Service officer.

2 About where were they positioned on this  
3 map?

4 A. So the Secret Service would have been at  
5 the end of the Brady Paul Lane.

6 Q. At the end of Brady Paul Lane, you can use  
7 that to mark --

8 A. Right there (indicating).

9 Q. Okay.

10 A. With Patrolman [REDACTED]. And then the  
11 trooper would have been --

12 Q. So that's sort of, just for the record,  
13 since the record can't see it, that's Brady Paul  
14 Lane at the intersection of where there's a yellow  
15 line basically or Brady Paul and Meridian Road?

16 That intersection is where you saw?

17 A. Yes. Brady Paul Lane.

18 Q. But at the intersection with Meridian is  
19 what I was just trying to understand.

20 And remind me. What was that  
21 interaction with the state trooper and Secret  
22 Service?

23 What did you discuss? Just --

24 A. So, I mean, it was a different interaction  
25 with Secret Service than it was with state police.

1 Q. Okay.

2 A. Which one are you referring to?

3 Q. That's helpful. I was conflating the two.

4 Maybe you can just again, very  
5 briefly -- you're patrolling. Who else do you see  
6 in the course of the day?

7 When do you see the trooper? When do  
8 you see the Secret Service officer?

9 A. So I saw [REDACTED] and the Secret Service is  
10 with [REDACTED] at Brady Paul Lane.

11 Q. Secret Service is with [REDACTED]?

12 A. I see him first.

13 Q. Got it. And I take it -- do you recall the  
14 Secret Service officer's name or anything?

15 A. No. Tall, thin guy.

16 Q. Around what time was that?

17 A. Tall, thin guy.

18 Q. Tall, thin guy. Around what time --

19 A. I suppose that describes most of them. I  
20 realize that. But tall, thin guy.

21 Q. Fair enough.

22 A. Younger guy.

23 Q. And were they stationed together? Did they  
24 just happen to be around the same --

25 A. I couldn't tell you.

Q. And what was the substance of that discussion with [REDACTED] and the Secret Service agent?

A. The picture he sent and then --

Q. So this is after you had received the text message from [REDACTED]?

A. Well, [REDACTED] sent me -- we talked about it before [REDACTED] sent it to me. I don't know when he sent it to me. I just don't know exactly because he was sending it to other people.

But we talked about it there. I went back to the water tower where I made contact with the trooper at the water tower, and I think I said then we did not know there was a trooper stationed there from the way the hills kind of roll down. I couldn't see him from there.

Like where we were standing on Brady Paul Lane, I don't think we could see the trooper there because [REDACTED] was like, "Do you want to go check over there at the water tower to see if he's over there?"

And then when I pulled up to the water tower, I could see there was a trooper there. I kind of figured he wasn't there but still looked around and said something to the trooper.

1 Q. Okay. Was there anybody else with the  
2 trooper there? Was there Secret Service up there?  
3 Anybody from Butler?

4 A. No. He was by himself.

5 Q. Was he in a car?

6 A. He was in a car by himself pretty much.

7 Q. And what discussion, if any, did you have  
8 with him?

9 A. Just that we were looking for this guy with  
10 a range finder.

11 Q. Okay. And at that point all you know is a  
12 guy with a range finder. Any other information  
13 about the potentially --

14 A. Just a description of a gray shirt, khaki  
15 shorts. I can't remember exactly, though.

16 Q. But no indication at that point that this  
17 person was armed or anything else?

18 A. No.

19 Q. Okay. At any point during the day did you  
20 see any drones flying?

21 Do you recall that?

22 A. No. We are told in the briefing -- I do  
23 remember this -- that if you see a drone, call him.

24 Q. So that was part of the briefing. Anything  
25 else?

1                   Now that that just triggered your  
2           memory, anything else about the briefing about  
3           particularly suspicious activity to keep an eye out  
4           for?

5           A.     If you see a drone, call it in.

6           Q.     And where would you have called it in?

7           A.     I would have called that in to the CP on  
8           OPS 3.

9           Q.     Okay. So you would have switched off of  
10          the channel that you were regularly --

11          A.     Yes.

12          Q.     Onto OPS 3. And did you have an  
13          understanding of where that OPS 3 channel was being  
14          monitored or who was monitoring it?

15          A.     That's out of my --

16          Q.     Fair enough.

17                   So once you go up and you meet with the  
18          trooper, remind me where you go from the water  
19          tower.

20          A.     I go back out onto the road. Stop and talk  
21          to --

22          Q.     Which road?

23          A.     Meridian Road.

24          Q.     Back on Meridian.

25          A.     And then I stopped and talked to [REDACTED]



1 again.

2 Q. Okay. And at that point what is that  
3 discussion with [REDACTED]?

4 A. There was some discussion, and the Secret  
5 Service said, "If you find him, we'll talk to him."  
6 Not to detain -- there was no discussion of  
7 detaining him or any of that stuff. "If you find  
8 him, we'll talk to him."

9 Q. And the "him" at this point is still just  
10 that suspicious person?

11 A. Yes.

12 Q. Light shirt. Nothing more than that.  
13 Okay.

14 And then what's the next step?

15 A. Well, the suspicious person, I do have a  
16 photograph, and it's that guy with a flat face. I  
17 seen him earlier. He's very recognizable.

18 And then I go down Meridian Road. I end  
19 up cutting back one of the other roads, and then I  
20 end up on 68 when the next call of events come in.

21 Q. And where's 68 on this map that we're  
22 looking at, if it's on here?

23 A. Right here (indicating).

24 [REDACTED]: That's Route 68.

25 Q. Route 68, that's sort of on the left side

1 running diagonal here?

2 A. It's -- it's --

3 [REDACTED]: Evans City Road?

4 [REDACTED]: Yeah. Evans City Road.

5 A. It's numbered on your map.

6 Q. Yes, it is.

7 A. That's why I said 68.

8 Q. Perfect. And 68 seems to sort of start to  
9 run behind the American Glass; right?

10 And is this where -- what happens at  
11 that point?

12 A. As I originally said, I'm on 68. I got a  
13 call that he's between AGR and Sheetz.

14 Q. Okay. So that's right here (indicating).

15 At any point do you leave your vehicle,  
16 or at what point to you leave your vehicle and  
17 switch to foot?

18 A. I don't leave my vehicle until I get out  
19 and we already know he's on the roof, and not long  
20 after that is when I hoisted Detective [REDACTED].

21 Q. And how did you know he was on the roof?

22 A. Patrolman [REDACTED].

23 Q. I'm sorry?

24 A. Patrolman [REDACTED] said there was a guy on the  
25 roof.

1 Q. Were you able, from your vantage point, to  
2 see him on the roof from the ground?

3 A. I never seen the guy.

4 Q. You never saw the guy.

5 So you hoisted Detective [REDACTED] onto  
6 the roof. What did Detective [REDACTED] say?

7 A. He was screaming, "THERE'S AN AR! AR!"  
8 Coming off the roof.

9 Q. Then what?

10 A. As I originally said, I backed away from  
11 the side of the building. I still can't see the  
12 guy. I radio it in, and then shots rang out.

13 Q. At any point did you go up onto the roof  
14 yourself?

15 A. No.

16 Q. Did you try to help Detective [REDACTED] go  
17 back up a second time?

18 A. I did.

19 Q. And what happened in that time?

20 Did he make it up onto the roof?

21 A. Yeah. There was nothing eventful now. He  
22 went up.

23 Q. At that point Mr. Crooks had been shot.

24 Did Detective [REDACTED] say what he saw up  
25 there?

1 A. That's up to Detective [REDACTED] to say that.

2 Q. Well, I'm asking what you --

3 A. I didn't talk to Detective [REDACTED] after  
4 that.

5 Q. Okay. So you put him on the roof and that  
6 was it?

7 A. I put him on the roof, and I didn't see him  
8 again, other than he called me and was like, "Hey,  
9 that's crazy. I gotta meet with you sometime."  
10 And that was it.

11 Q. Okay. So you never saw him again that day?

12 A. No. He had, as you know, an ankle injury,  
13 and he went from that location -- after the  
14 adrenalin wore off, he ended up realizing that he  
15 did have an ankle injury and went to the hospital.

16 Q. At any point throughout this, are you  
17 wearing a body-worn camera?

18 A. I was not.

19 Q. You were not?

20 A. It was docked in the car.

21 Q. Say it again.

22 A. It was docked in the car.

23 Q. It was docked --

24 A. When I jumped out of the car, I forgot to  
25 grab it and put it on.

1 Q. Okay. Does your car have a dash camera?

2 A. Yes.

3 Q. An in-car camera? Was that on at any point  
4 during the day, that you recall?

5 A. I don't know. I don't know if the  
6 lieutenant went back and possibly recorded it. I  
7 don't know what's on it.

8 Whatever's available, he would have  
9 given you. Where I was parked, I don't know if  
10 you'll get much from it, if anything.

11 Q. I'm just checking a couple things. One  
12 moment.

13 At some point you mentioned, when you  
14 were speaking to our colleagues, that you mentioned  
15 "we did a timeline."

16 What timeline were you referring to?

17 A. We turned in a timeline of our events to  
18 the lieutenant.

19 Q. Okay. Was that a written document you  
20 created, or did you just give him sort of an oral  
21 download?

22 A. It was a document -- or it was put into  
23 Visual Alert, our reporting.

24 [REDACTED]: Visual Alert?

25 [REDACTED]: Yeah.

1 MR. KELLY: Yes. Please, Chairman.

2 BY MR. KELLY:

3 Q. So, [REDACTED], you went on duty that  
4 morning at 8:00?

5 A. Correct.

6 Q. What time did you receive this and who did  
7 you receive it from?

8 A. It would have been like 9 or 10 in the  
9 morning. It would have been from the lieutenant,  
10 and he would have given a briefing.

11 Q. When you said they were doing a briefing,  
12 who are the "they" that were doing the briefing?

13 A. The other officers. I sat in on the  
14 briefing.

15 Q. Any Secret Service in the room briefing  
16 also?

17 A. No. There was no Secret Service. It was  
18 just Butler Township officers. It was at Butler  
19 Township with Butler Township officers.

20 Q. So you went on duty at 8. At 9:00 or  
21 somewhere around 9:00 or 10:00, you go in with the  
22 other officers of Butler Township?

23 A. Yes.

24 Q. Did you get a copy of this?

25 A. Correct. I get a copy and I put it in

1 my --

2 Q. So other than that meeting and this  
3 document, was there any other meeting, briefing,  
4 pregame talk?

5 I mean, was there anything else as far  
6 as what the expectations were that day?

7 If I said, "Okay, Officer [REDACTED]. Do  
8 you have any questions about anything that's shown  
9 in here? Do you know where you're supposed to be  
10 and what you're supposed to be looking at?"

11 A. We talked amongst our local colleagues  
12 about it, yeah.

13 Q. Which I would assume you would do, yeah.

14 A. Yeah.

15 Q. Okay. So what do you think? How many  
16 people do you think were there that day?

17 A. I have no idea.

18 Q. Just a ballpark. You're allowed to be off  
19 by 10,000 if you want.

20 A. I don't even know if I can be in by 10,000.  
21 20,000.

22 Q. Okay. All right.

23 A. I heard 25,000. I don't even know if that  
24 was accurate.

25 Q. So what I'm trying to think of, at the

1 times I've been out and gone to whatever it is I've  
2 gone to, it's amazing to me that the only person  
3 that comes up in the whole day is somebody with  
4 long hair, a gray tee shirt, and light khaki pants.

5 So that person keeps coming up. So I'm  
6 thinking of all the thousands of people all over  
7 that field, do you know what? There is one person  
8 that's really suspicious. I've got to think -- I'm  
9 not a law enforcement officer -- but for some  
10 reason this is the lead of who it is we're looking  
11 for and where we're trying to find him because it  
12 seems to me the back and forth, everything that  
13 happened after that, is you all trying to get at,  
14 "Where is he now? I see him. No, he's not there  
15 now. I can't find him. Where did he come in  
16 from?" There was a lot of conversation about him  
17 on a bicycle.

18 But that's the only person, of all the  
19 thousands of people that traversed that whole area  
20 that day, that we think is suspicious.

21 So there must be something about him  
22 that you all just get a sense of, and if we weren't  
23 able to batten down the hatches on where he was  
24 when we were looking for him and knowing that the  
25 former president of the United States was going to



1 be out there, was there no conversation: "You know  
2 what? Hold him up until we actually find out where  
3 this suspicious person is."

4 Because the only person that gets  
5 described by any of you -- by the way, I'm not  
6 pointing the finger at you -- the only person that  
7 comes up out of all those thousands of people that  
8 were on that property that day, the only one that  
9 comes up consistently is this one. Is this one.  
10 Long hair. Glasses. Has this shirt on. Has these  
11 pants on.

12 It's just odd to me that of all of that  
13 population that was on that field, there's one  
14 person that sticks out to everybody who's in law  
15 enforcement.

16 So who is that getting filtered to at  
17 the command center? So I'm trying to understand  
18 this. So all these reports, who does it go in to  
19 and who then makes the decision of, "Hey, do you  
20 know what? Until we locate him, until we actually  
21 talk to him and have a conversation, let's keep  
22 Trump back in the tent"?

23 I mean --

24 A. I don't have the answer for you on that  
25 one.

1 Q. Do you know what? Nobody's able to give it  
2 to us.

3 A. Do you know what I mean? Where I was --

4 Q. I think you guys did a hell of a job. I  
5 mean, if somebody threw this to me before we kick  
6 off for the Super Bowl -- if I said, "So what's my  
7 assignment?" "Well, you guys just kind of hang  
8 around. You do what you always do. Everything's  
9 going to be all right."

10 So I'm trying to think, when we say a  
11 command post, who's in the command post and who's  
12 the pilot on that plane that's going to be able to  
13 direct?

14 And when people tell me, "Well, you  
15 don't understand. Because of the different  
16 frequencies, we couldn't understand each other."  
17 At some point somebody should have said, "Stop this  
18 show right now. If we can't communicate, we can't  
19 continue."

20 And if we see a suspicious person -- and  
21 many people see him at different times -- you guys  
22 are experts at picking out people, except for that  
23 day. You had already picked him out. You quit  
24 seeing him, but for some reason, somebody at some  
25 point should have said, "Stop the music. We don't

1 know where he is now. Now we're really starting to  
2 wonder."

3 And I hate to keep beating on this,  
4 guys, but I just cannot for the life of me  
5 understand, when we got the most elite group on the  
6 face of the earth when it comes to protecting  
7 special folks. I don't know where they were that  
8 day.

9 So you start at 8:00. What time did you  
10 finish up? 10:00 at night.

11 A. Like midnight.

12 Q. Midnight? Long day.

13 A. And back out at 8 the next morning.

14 Q. You guys are good. Thank you.

15 And I don't want to keep -- this is the  
16 one consistent thing that runs through this whole  
17 thing: Somebody's got to be in the booth.  
18 Somebody's got to be in the booth calling out the  
19 next offensive play and the next defensive play to  
20 keep the offense from scoring.

21 I am just amazed that on that day, all  
22 that experience, all that training, all that prep  
23 work seemed to disappear. But it comes down to one  
24 person out of the thousands that were back and  
25 forth all over that field in the hottest day of the

1 summer. People collapsing. Right? But the only  
2 one they remember is a guy in that outfit with a  
3 gray shirt and khaki pants, long hair.

4 The team's got a hell of a job in front  
5 of it. No, we really do. We really do. We really  
6 do.

7 Officer, good job. Good job. Good job.

8 [REDACTED]: Thank you, sir. I think  
9 we can be off the record at 5:27.

10 (Off the record.)

11 [REDACTED]: We'll go back on the record.

12 BY [REDACTED]

13 Q. [REDACTED], just in describing your  
14 responsibilities, you referred to taking calls as  
15 something that you usually do at the Butler  
16 Township Police Department.

17 Can you just again explain what taking a  
18 call means as a police officer at Butler Township  
19 Police Department?

20 What does that entail?

21 A. The radio calls us -- or Butler County 911  
22 Center, control center, whatever you want to call  
23 them, calls me on the radio.

24 I respond back on the radio. They say  
25 either go to this address or call this person, and

1       then I call that person or go to that address for  
2       their issue, whatever it may be. It could be  
3       anything.

4           Q.     Just as far as radiofrequencies are  
5       concerned, on the fourth page of the Butler  
6       Township Operational Plan, it lists Butler Township  
7       personnel and also the frequencies.

8                   Are you looking at that same document?

9           A.     Yeah.

10          Q.     Under radiofrequencies, it has patrol as  
11       Police 2; Detail as OPS 3; and Team 400 as OPS 4.

12                   Do you understand what each of those  
13       mean in terms of who would be receiving what  
14       information on what frequency?

15          A.     I'm not following you on that one.

16          Q.     So OPS 3 is radio communications for Butler  
17       Township police; correct?

18          A.     That would be the detail for. And I don't  
19       know if -- so when you say detail for OPS 3, I'm  
20       assuming that's not just Butler Township but  
21       whatever other county is there, county radio.

22                   I'm assuming state is not on that same  
23       frequency because their radios don't talk to our  
24       radios.

25                   So I'm assuming the sheriff's

department's there. They would probably be on  
Detail - OPS 3, but again, I don't know.

Q. Okay.

A. So everybody from the detail would be OPS  
3.

Q. Thank you. Does Team 400 mean anything to  
you listed under radiofrequencies?

Do you know what that means?

A. That would be the ESU team or the ESU team  
and whatever assets they have with them.

Q. Okay. I just want to move on.

The first time that you identified  
Crooks, you identified, you know, his person. He  
stood out to you.

You had mentioned earlier that you  
recognized him earlier in the day. Can you  
describe where he was when you first saw him?

A. As I said earlier, I don't remember. I  
don't recall. He has a very recognizable face,  
and when I seen it, I said, "I seen that guy  
earlier today."

I can't remember for the life of me. I  
was racking my brain all day trying to figure out  
where he was and I couldn't.

BY [REDACTED]:

1 Q. Had you worked an event for a presidential  
2 candidate before?

3 A. No.

4 Q. Had you worked an event for 2020 when then-  
5 President Trump came to Butler?

6 A. No.

7 Q. Did you have in your mind any expectation  
8 about the Secret Service's role in managing the  
9 July 13 event?

10 A. I don't know how to comment on that one.

11 [REDACTED]: I don't think you can  
12 because you weren't involved in the planning.

13 Q. And you were not involved in any meeting  
14 between the Secret Service in which the Secret  
15 Service was present at any point on the day of  
16 July 13?

17 A. No.

18 Q. On the day of the rally, the conversation  
19 between you and Patrolman [REDACTED] and the Secret  
20 Service agent you recall being with him, is that  
21 the only time you interacted with the Secret  
22 Service personnel, that you're aware of?

23 A. After I cleared the building real quickly,  
24 I talked to one. I don't think we had anything  
25 important to say, really, but I had interaction

1 with them when I walked out of the building and we  
2 were like, "Oh, get gloves and, you know, run those  
3 over to the guys."

4 But that was it. That was the only  
5 other actions, really.

6 Q. Did anyone tell you at any point when you  
7 would have to talk to Secret Service?

8 A. I was not told that I would have to talk to  
9 Secret Service. Period.

10 Q. Were you ever told when you may have to  
11 talk to state police?

12 A. At the CP that night.

13 Q. And then what about had you received any  
14 direction to ever reach out to the local command  
15 post with the ESU presence, with the sheriff's  
16 presence, with the EMS presence?

17 Do you know what I'm referring to?

18 A. No.

19 Q. There was a local trailer that had those  
20 representatives from those different entities.

21 Does that ring a bell at all?

22 A. No. I wasn't there.

23 Q. And then had you known at the time that  
24 there was a Secret Service command post and a local  
25 command post?



1 A. I didn't know that at the time.

2 Q. And Patrolman [REDACTED], did he direct you to  
3 go to the AGR building?

4 A. Me and him talked about it. We're like,  
5 "Yeah, why don't you go check." That was the water  
6 tower, not the AGR building.

7 Q. Were there other law enforcement around you  
8 and Detective [REDACTED] the second time you lifted  
9 him up on the roof?

10 A. Yeah. The ESU guys, they have a lot more  
11 gear on them, and they have a lot of stuff on them.  
12 Some of them are pretty big boys, and they were  
13 having some trouble getting on the roof. That's  
14 why I got [REDACTED] back up there.

15 Q. Did they say anything to you?

16 A. What do you mean?

17 Q. Did they say anything to you?

18 A. Not other than like, "Hey, hoist me," you  
19 know.

20 Q. Were you involved with lifting anyone else  
21 on the roof successfully?

22 A. Yeah, but successfully? Like I said, some  
23 of them couldn't get on the roof.

24 So I believe we pushed one up, pushed  
25 [REDACTED] up, and then there was another guy that

1       couldn't get up there.

2           Q.     Had you received or did you already have in  
3     your mind under your police department's protocol  
4     about guidance on who or who should not approach  
5     the threat, in this case being Mr. Crooks?

6                     So was there any sense of who the person  
7     should be to respond to the neutralized threat at  
8     that time?

9           A.     I don't think we really briefed in on that.  
10    I'm not involved with planning, so... Again, I was  
11    covering the road.

12                    ██████████:   That's all the questions for  
13    us. We'll go off the record. Thank you so much.

14                    (Off the record.)

15                    ██████████:   Back on the record at  
16    5:36.

17    BY ██████████:

18           Q.     I just want to clarify one point that my  
19    colleague was just asking about.

20                    I think her question was along the lines  
21    of if you had any instructions on speaking to state  
22    police that day.

23                    You said you spoke to them later in the  
24    day after, but there was no instruction, and that  
25    was sort of as a recap or a debriefing on the day?

1           A.    Yeah. I don't even know if they knew what  
2 we did. I don't think they did. That's why we got  
3 to the CP that night. I don't even think they knew  
4 what we did.

5           Q.    Understood. But it wasn't that during the  
6 course of the day you had any instruction of how to  
7 direct with state police?

8                    "You should be speaking with them  
9 because we're not on the same channels," nothing  
10 like that?

11          A.    Again, I wasn't in planning. I was  
12 covering the roads.

13          Q.    Understood. But nothing in the briefing  
14 suggested you should be in contact with your state  
15 counterparts?

16          A.    No.

17          Q.    And I just want to make sure I understood  
18 what I understood you to be clarifying: Was that  
19 when you spoke to [REDACTED], he said to go check  
20 the water tower, not to go check AGR?

21          A.    Correct. Water tower. She said AGR.

22          Q.    Right. I just want to make sure the record  
23 was clear on that point. Okay. That's it. Thank  
24 you so much.

25                   [REDACTED] We'll go off the record.

(Interviewee excused.)

(The interview concluded at 5:40 p.m.)
