Trump on July 13, 2024, in Butler, Pennsylvania.

Schedule for Production

Please produce all records in the possession, custody, or control of the Department of Justice (DOJ), the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), or any officer or employee thereof, in unreducted form:

- 1. Any briefing materials, written testimony, prepared remarks, and handouts prepared for and/or provided to Members of Congress or congressional staff during, or in connection with any hearings, briefings, press events, or any private or public events referring or related to the attempted assassination of Donald J. Trump on July 13, 2024, in Butler, Pennsylvania (the "July 13 event"), including the timeline of events as described during a briefing for Task Force Members and staff on August 21, 2024.
- 2. An organizational chart showing the structural chains of command between or among all DOJ and FBI divisions and teams involved in the criminal and/or counterterrorism investigations of the July 13 event.
- 3. All communications, including emails, text messages, phone logs, or other messaging services, referring or related to the July 13 event, between or among FBI officials, including the FBI Pittsburgh Field Office, and the U.S. Secret Service or the Pennsylvania State Police.
- 4. A copy of all Special Event Threat Assessments related to the July 13 event.
- 5. All FD-302 forms and/or transcripts for witness interviews related to the July 13 event, including but not limited to the following witnesses, or witnesses associated with the following agencies, entities, and individuals:
 - a. U.S. Secret Service;
 - b. State and local law enforcement, including Butler County Sheriff's Office, Butler Township Police Department, Butler County Emergency Services Unit, Beaver County Emergency Services Unit, Washington County Emergency Services Unit, and the Pennsylvania State Police;
 - c. Butler County Emergency Services;
 - d. Butler County Office of the Coroner;
 - e. Allegheny County Office of the Medical Examiner;
 - f. Thomas Matthew Crooks' immediate family;
 - g. Allegheny Arms & Gun Works, including owners, employees, and customers;
 - h. Former President Donald J. Trump;

- i. Donald J. Trump for President 2024, Inc.;
- j. Representatives or employees of American Glass Research (AGR); and
- k. Clairton Sportsmen's Club owners and customers.
- 6. All documents and communications referring or relating to the FBI's identification of Crooks on July 13, 2024.
- 7. All documents and communications referring or relating to Crooks' use of encrypted messaging accounts.
- 8. All documents and communications referring or relating to the FBI's analysis of Crooks' electronic devices, including analysis of Crooks' plans for remote detonations, and Crooks' drone.
- 9. All documents and communications referring or related to the FBI's ballistic analysis of all shots fired at the July 13 event.
- 10. All documents and communications referring or relating to the FBI's crime scene for the July 13 event, including but not limited to the Memorandum of Understanding between the FBI and USSS related to control of the crime scene, and documents and communications related to cleaning the American Glass Research building's roof.
- 11. An inventory log of all evidence associated with the July 13 event.
- 12. All intelligence related to threats to former President Trump that were considered active, ongoing, or unresolved between and including July 1-13, 2024, regardless of whether such threats were specific to Thomas crooks or the July 13 event and regardless of when such threats originated.
- 13. A copy of all evidence obtained by the FBI related to the investigation of the July 13 event and Crooks, including but not limited to videos, recordings, encrypted messaging accounts, social media accounts, phones, computers, or other electronic devices. For any evidence which cannot physically be turned over to the Task Force, please provide an opportunity to view and examine such evidence, including but not limited to Crooks' rifle as recovered and broken down, Crooks' backpack as recovered, the improvised explosive devices discovered in the trunk of Crooks' car, and the vehicle(s) impounded in the investigation.
- 14. All documents and communications referring or relating to the autopsy, toxicology report, and coroner's report for Crooks, as well as any additional information concerning the intake, evaluation, examination, or disposition of his body, including but not limited to the release of his body to his family.
- 15. A copy of all search warrants related to the July 13 event.

- 16. A copy of all subpoenas related to the July 13 event.
- 17. All documents and information related to any potential connection between the attempted assassination on July 13 and the attempted assassination on September 15, 2024.

Schedule for Interviews

Please make available for transcribed interviews the officers and employees of the Department of Justice (DOJ) and/or the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) who served in, or are presently serving in the following roles related to the July 13 event:

- 1. The lead FBI agent(s) investigating the July 13 event.
- 2. The FBI Pittsburgh Field Office agent(s) who received communications from any U.S. Secret Service agent or employee related to the July 13 event.
- 3. The FBI agent(s) who have conducted interviews associated with the July 13 event, including joint interviews with the Pennsylvania State Police witnesses.
- 4. The FBI agent(s) who observed, participated in, or contributed to Thomas Matthew Crooks' autopsy and coroner's report.
- 5. The FBI agent(s) responsible for analyzing any evidence related to the July 13 event.
- 6. The FBI agent(s) responsible for analyzing intelligence related to foreign threats against former President Trump and/or the July 13 event.
